

# INFO of EXTREME IMPORTANCE FOR JR & SR CAMP

## What to bring:

- Clean Clothes for each day
- Bedding (sleeping bag, pillow, teddy bear, etc.)
- Soap, toothbrush, deodorant, toe jam removal devices, etc.
- Great attitude and willingness to meet new friends and get involved!
- Nice clothes for evening services – nice shorts & shirts are acceptable
- Your BIBLE & a writing utensil
- Something to get WET in on water day. (NO 2 PIECE swimsuits.) T-Shirts must be worn by guys and girls on water day.

## DO NOT BRING:

- Drugs (other than YOUR prescriptions), alcohol or tobacco products of any kind! (These will get you sent home, we do not want that!)
- Firearms, knives, weapons of any kind (This will get you sent home, we do not want that!)
- iPods, stereos, TV's, cell phones
- COLD HARD CASH (not needed – all snacks at the canteen are already paid for!)
- A BAD ATTITUDE (Leave it at home or on the street outside camp – we are here to have some SERIOUS FUN!!)

## Camp Rules

1. Have Fun
2. Be Nice to Others
3. Smile and Laugh A LOT!
4. No Smoking, Drugs, Cussing or mean, hateful words
5. No leaving your dorm after lights out for ANY reason without an adult or counselor
6. Keep the camp clean – NO LITTERING!
7. NO firearms, knives, weapons of any kind or fireworks allowed!
8. NO IPOD's, or other types of MP3 players, radios, DVD players, TV's, etc.
9. Cell Phones are to remain turned OFF inside your suitcase / bag at ALL times unless you are given permission from the Camp Staff. (IT WOULD BE BEST NOT TO BRING ONE AT ALL!)
10. Stay Away from the Lake
11. Senior Campers who drive themselves may be asked to turn in their car keys once they get to camp.
12. No leaving camp for any reason without signing out with permission from the Camp Directors. Jr Campers MUST have a parent or LEGAL Guardian pick them up if they need to leave camp early for any reason.
